103 years of age.

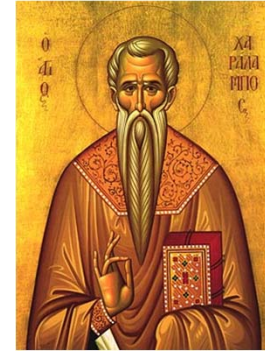
Agios Haralambos is commemorated on
